## How to help your child choose?

### School

Throughout the cycle d'orientation (CO), students can attend a class which enables them to familiarize themselves with the working world, to get to know themselves better and to move ahead with their choices for the future.

### Parents

You have the most influence on your child's choices. You accompany their thought process, support them with the various procedural steps they have to take and share your experience with them.

### Academic and Vocational Guidance

Psychologist counselors and guidance counselors are available in each CO and collaborate closely with the teachers. They inform students and answer their questions. As of the first semester of 10CO, the students (and their parents) can contact them for counseling.

- Information Day in schools (Journée des métiers) or trip to the Trades Fair (Your Challenge)
