

LAVI - Help for Victims of Criminal Offences

- Have you suffered from an attack linked to a criminal offence such as assault, rape, sexual abuse, domestic violence, threats, a road accident, etc. that has affected your physical, sexual or psychological integrity?
- Have you suffered from prejudice as a direct result of the offence?
- Do you still feel the effects of a previous traumatic experience?
- Do you live in fear of such events happening again?

The LAVI Centres inform and support you in order to help you cope with the consequences of the offence. The interviews are confidential and free of charge, anonymity is guaranteed.

You will find:

- a sympathetic ear, support, advice;
- information on your rights;
- an accompaniment for legal and administrative formalities;
- material help if necessary;
- a referral to specialist partners (doctors, psychologists, lawyers, emergency accomodation, etc.)

You've been a victim of a criminal offence, what to do?

- go to a safe place and, if possible, keep evidence of the offence;
- Call an emergency service:
 - Police: 117
 - Medical emergencies (ambulance): 144;
- Go to a doctor you trust or the nearest hospital for medical treatment and get a medical report;
- Contact a LAVI Centre or ask someone you trust to contact us for you.
