

This event has been organized within the framework of the exhibition *Let's Walk: Take a step, take a stand*, presented at Le Pénitencier from June 3rd, 2017 until the January 7th, 2018.

Since the late 1960s, Hamish Fulton (b. 1946) has been using walks as an artistic medium throughout the world. Exploring the terrain alone, he approaches the environment with respect and focuses on the experience of being in the landscape. He makes no on site interventions, but concentrates on the contemplative and receptive aspects of the walk. Fulton has developed an alternative model of land art. Each walk results in a work of art produced in different media (photography, mural painting, banner, wooden objects). The group walks that he occasionally organizes allow other people to enter his artistic world. The last group walk took place at the Centre Pompidou in Paris in February 2017.
